Redevelopment of torists sites in the municipality. The Greenwich Meridian passes through a number of settlements in the Municipality. Yendi, Bago, Laatam, Lumpua, Gbetobu, Gbungbaliga and Nakpachei. The Member of Parliament for the Yendi Constituency in erected a Tower at the site where the Greenwich Meridian passes through the Yendi township. This has made the site more visible to people especially people visiting for the first time.
